The WTC Health Program provides medical screening and treatment to those who qualify. A few of the covered health conditions include 9/11 cough, certain cancers, breathing issues, and PTSD.

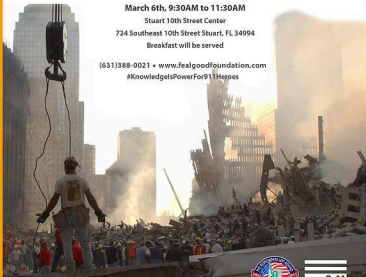
